Consent for Eyebrow Microblading Procedure

I _____ am over the age of 18, not under the influence of drugs or alcohol, and choose to receive the indicated microblading of eyebrows performed.

The general nature of cosmetic tattooing as well as the specific procedure to be performed has been explained to me.

I have been informed of the nature, risks, and possible complications and consequences of permanent skin pigmentation. I understand the permanent skin pigmentation procedure carries with it known and unknown complications and consequences associated with this type of cosmetic procedure, including but not limited to: infection, allergic reaction, scarring, inconsistent color, and spreading, fanning or fading of pigments.

I acknowledge that it is not reasonably possible to determine whether I might have an allergic reaction to any of the pigments, dyes, topical preparations, or processes used in the procedure, and I agree to accept the risk that such reaction is possible. Secondary infection in the area of the procedure may occur, however if properly cared for, is rare.

I understand the actual color of the pigment may be modified slightly, due to the tone and color of my skin.

I fully understand this is a tattoo process and therefore not an exact science, but an art.

I request the microblading procedure and accept the permanence of the procedure as well as the possible complications and consequences of the said procedure.

I understand that while this is sometimes referred to as semi-permanent in nature, due to each individual's reaction to pigment, the length of time pigment is present cannot be guaranteed. In some cases, pigment will be permanent.

I understand that if I have any skin treatments, laser hair removal, plastic surgery or other skin altering procedures, it may result in adverse changes to my permanent cosmetics.

I acknowledge some of these potential adverse changes may not be correctable.

I have received pre-and post procedure instructions and I will strictly adhere to such instructions.

Timeless Beauty

I understand that my failure to do so may jeopardize my chances for a successful procedure.

If I am on any medication for depression or any other mood altering prescription, I will advise my technician

I understand that the taking of before and after photographs of the said procedure is a condition of such procedure.

I certify I have read all the above paragraphs and have had explained to my understanding this consent and the procedure process.

I accept full responsibility for the decision to have this cosmetic tattoo work done.

I have received a copy of the Pre and Aftercare Instructions in this consent form

I am fully aware that the 2nd session is only included if your original appointment is kept. If you must reschedule, you will be charged 3rd session fee of \$75.

If a 3rd session is needed due to skin type, medical conditions or un-foreseen reasons, a \$75 session fee will be charged. **YOU MUST REQUEST 3RD SESSION NO LATER THAN 6 WEEKS FROM YOUR 2ND SESSION, OTHERWISE IT WILL BE CONSIDERED A TOUCHUP AT THE REGULAR RATE.**

All procedure requires 2 appointments and touch up every 12-18 months to keep the color fresh.

I acknowledge and understand that if I have oily/severely oily skin the pigment could heal/appear much softer and can look more solid and powdery due the overproduction of oil glands. The pigment will fade quicker look blurred or more solid over time.

I acknowledge and understand that pigment implanted darker skin types (Indian, African American, Asians, etc.) will appear softer and blend more with your own skin's melanin and will not appear as bold or defined as on lighter skin types and the hair strokes will be less visible.

Alopecia client's strokes may heal more soft and powdery/blurred looking. Thyroid condition and medications can prevent pigment from retaining, fade quickly or change in color. If I am prone to Keloid scars on the face are less likely, I have been advised that if I am prone to keloid scarring there is a chance this procedure can produce keloid scars. I have accepted these potential risks and wish to proceed.

I acknowledge that the procedure will result in a permanent change to my appearance and that no representations have been made to me as to later change or remove the result. I understand there are no guarantees have been made to me concerning the results of procedure. This is not the fault of the technician

If you have had tattoo removal prior to seeing Martha Abruzzese/ TimelessBeautyAZ, LLC due to scar tissue the pigment may not retain. Further procedures may not be an option and I understand there are No Refunds. I also understand that if any other technician applies permanent makeup over that area that was originally done by Martha, she will no longer perform further treatments.

Absolutely No refunds after services have been performed

In the event of MRI, please inform your physician of your Permanent Cosmetic as some pulling or burning sensation (rare) may occur during the procedure.

How to Prepare for Permanent Makeup Appointment

Do not work out the day of the procedure.

Do not get any facial treatments or Botox/Dysport 2 weeks prior to your procedure.

Do not have a sunburned face when coming in for your procedure.

You must be off all Retinols for 7 days prior to your appointment.

Do not take Aspirin, Niacin, Vitamin E, Fish Oil and/or Ibuprofen 24 hours prior to your procedure.

Please do not discontinue any of these if medically prescribed by your physician. Tylenol is fine.

No alcohol 24 hours prior to the procedure.

Come to your appointment with your eyebrows penciled the way you like the. If you do not normally do this do not worry about it.

If using eyelash growth serum (Latisse) or there like, you must discontinue 4 weeks prior to procedure and wait until 4 weeks after procedure before continuing use (for lash liner only).

Do not wear contact lenses

Children are not allowed in the studio during procedure.

After care

1 hour after procedure, wash brows with soap provided and rinse well with water.

Pat dry with paper towel, once skin is completely dry apply a very thin layer of ointment. Brows should look shiny but you should not see a thick layer of ointment. Apply pressure while applying/spreading ointment almost as if you are wiping it off.

OINTMENT LAYER SHOULD BE VERY THIN!

Repeat the entire process (wash/dry/Aquaphor) 3-4 times a day for 10 days. Keep brows dry except for when you are washing them (no swimming and cover in shower with wash cloth).

No working out for 10 days, sweat will not heal nicely missing and blurred strokes!

You will need to get more soap like Dial Gold or fragrance free baby shampoo works well too.

Hang onto the ointment; it is enough for both sessions. IF you need more only purchase Aquaphor.

Timeless Beauty

Your brows will look darker and possibly reddish the first 10 days. DO NOT JUDGE YOUR BROWS THE FIRST 10 DAYS. Remember they are only ½ done after the first session.

Long-Term Care After first 10 days

Avoid potent skincare products on eyebrows; this includes anything extremely exfoliating, acids chemical peels, retinols, skin bleachers
Apply a day cream SPF over your brows to prevent fading
